WHO WE ARE

We are a youth-based NGO in Mumbai empowering underprivileged youth with the power of Education. We work predominantly for the Education and Healthcare of vulnerable youngsters (age group - 16 to 26 years). Our major focus is on providing proper guidance to distressed youth & teenagers in deciding the right direction and see their progress in a few years. We aim for a holistic development with a major focus on value-based education.

We are currently a team of more than 200 volunteers with diverse activities. We provide our children with interactive study materials, innovative teaching tools, personal counseling, physical fitness activities, hygiene practices, mental support, career guidance, and art & skill development workshops to help them achieve notable transformation in respect to values and academic orientation. We also provide Medical Aid, Mental well-being workshops, and Doctoral support to our beneficiaries.

Shridhar(President) and Sampada(Secretary) realized the importance of connecting the right values and right direction with education for the overall growth of less fortunate children. They took a major step forward and started 'weCHANGE' in Thane on December 17th, 2014.

OUR TOP PROJECTS

DHARMENDRA MISHRA HEALTH CARE FUND

The initiative aims at providing medical help to the most needed less fortunate people in society. The funds arranged will be put to use for medical requirements like Ambulance service, hospital treatments, and medicines. This Health Care fund is a result of a tragic incident in the past when 'weCHANGE' took efforts to help a badly injured unemployed man on the streets with an infected leg.

Even though we could restore his hope and faith in humanity, we couldn't save him as his infection was already in a worse condition. While taking efforts and struggle to get him hospitalised for treatments, we realised the need to provide medical support for the most unfortunate people. There were funds arranged and more funds coming in for this purpose which we intend to use for providing medical support to the most needful people.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP CELL INITIATIVES





Stitching Hopes was launched under the Entrepreneurship cell initiative. It is lead by Amrit Kaur and Nidhi Chedda. Its primary goals include providing employment to marginalized communities; Provide skill-based training; Generate employment and small income setups to help our manufacturers be more self-sustainable; Provide educational support and a career-based certification program to our students. It also gave hope to Artisans to keep dreaming higher in spite of the Pandemic. Books and earphones were also given to the children of Artisans.

Cow Dung Diyas is our New venture lead by Krishna Gangwani to go Vocal for Locals. The main aim is to provide alternatives to traditional utilities. It is in collaboration with Eco Mummy to promote Eco-friendly Products.

FLAGSHIP MENTORSHIP PROGRAMME

young people find it hard to choose the right direction when it comes to their career. It is even worse for the underprivileged youth to make a decision. The mentorship programme acts as a *guiding force* for their dreams and aspiration. "**Be a Mentor**" was launched during the academic year of 2019-20. It aims for the overall development of individual students assigned to each mentor. Funds were arranged through the '**Suraksha Bandhan**' fundraising initiative. The programme includes value-based education, beneficiary centric initiatives, personal counselling, and financial support. Currently, there are 13 mentors &15 mentees at Kshamata and 22 mentors & 22 mentees at ENS, Kamshet.

Despite the lockdown, mentors continued with their responsibilities effectively with the use of digital platforms to cater to the requirements of the mentees on a daily basis. Mentors helped our students to easily understand the concepts and successfully pass their academic courses. All mentors made sure that they establish a rapport with their students which they believe is the building stone of the mentorship programme. It also sponsored the fees and books for students. We thank our senior mentors for their guidance and for making this initiative a success.

CHANGE MAKERS 2020

The key motto of CHANGE MAKERS 2020 was to test and develop the creative and articulative skills of our students. Based on the age groups, teams divided had to perform various team bonding & strategy building activities:-

1) Come up with a name, logo, and slogan for their groups.

- 2) Bridge the Gap Make the strongest bridge using waste materials like cardboard, newspapers, etc. to test their teamwork skills, convincing power, and thought process.
- 3) Testing Entrepreneurship skills Advertise & market useless waste products like a pen without refill, non-working earphones, etc. as a skit for 2 minutes which tests their creativity, innovativeness, time management, and convincing power.
- 4) Concluded with a surprise event of the **Secret Santa** initiative. In the end, appreciation medals and certificates were awarded. There were also fun activities.

NGO Bazaar was a platform that facilitated Kamshet kids to sell their products in Mithibai College, Mumbai.

'weCHANGE' had teamed up with the Rotaract club of Ruia College which gave an opportunity to showcase one's talents. Events included a Storytelling workshop and a skit titled "Mi Kon" (meaning 'Who Am I') that enacted the story of an orphan and how weCHANGE helps him/her in finding the right direction. 






VOCATIONAL TRAINING:-
